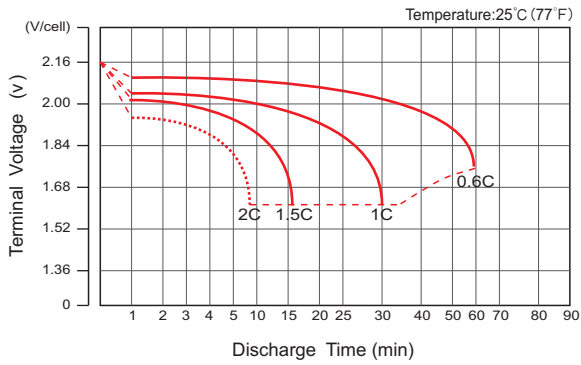

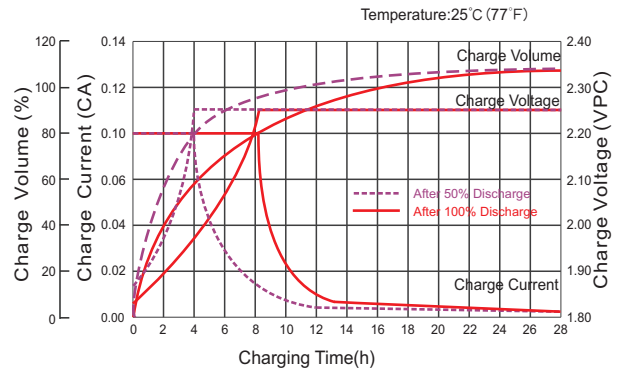

## Discharge Characteristics Curve



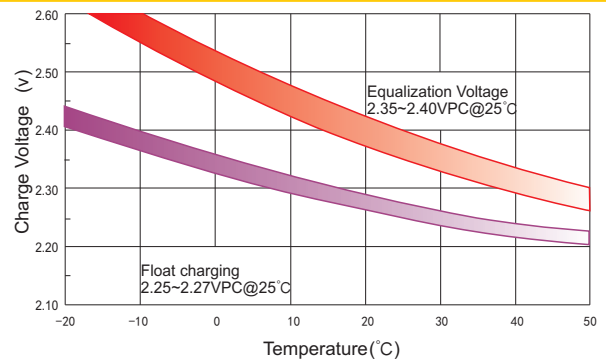
## Charge Characteristic Curve For Floating Use



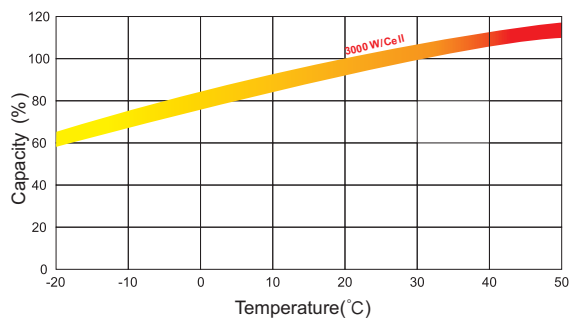

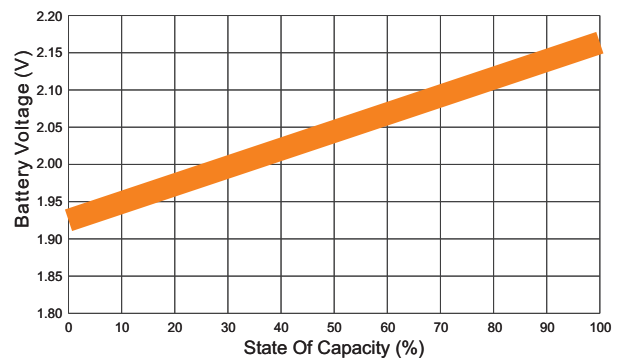
## Relationship Between Charging Voltage And Temperature



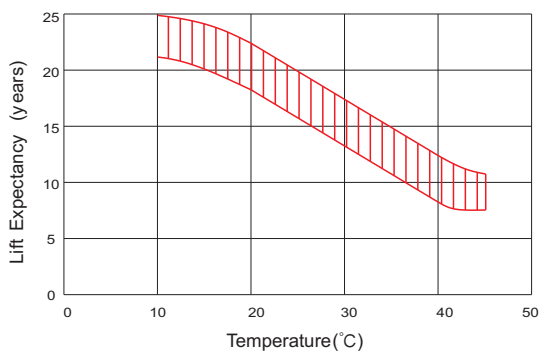
## Temperature Effects On Capacity



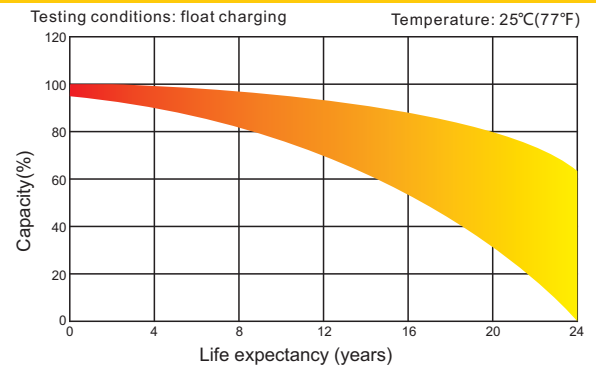
## Relationship of OCV And State of Charge(20°C)
